

Youth On A Mission (YOAM) is an auxiliary of the Department of Missions, of the Church Of God In Christ, Inc. The role of YOAM is to minister to youth and adults in a foreign country. Churches Of God In Christ may be found in approximately 53 countries. Every year YOAM visits a foreign country to support the work there.

In 1979, YOAM was born from the vision of Bishop Carlis L. Moody. Bishop Moody appointed Elder J. W. Denny as the director of YOAM, after sending him for training. Trips usually last for two weeks. The daily YOAM schedule includes early morning devotions and debriefings, breakfast, building project(s), vacation Bible school, street ministry, dinner and nightly evangelistic services. YOAM teams have been to Liberia, Panama, Dominican Republic, Philippines, Chile, Brazil, Bahamas, Turks Islands, Malawi, North Dakota (Native American Reservations), Nigeria, Ghana, Haiti, Mexico, Belize, Trinidad/Tobago, Jamaica, South Africa, Cuba, Brazil and Guyana. The 2014 teams are schedule for Virgin Islands, Costa Rica, Belize and Guatemala. One team will be going to two countries.
